I met Jennifer when I was struggling in a learning group where another student had been particularly difficult towards me. Jennifer was my lifeline in that experience—like a life ring thrown to a drowning person. And now, years later, I get to teach her students and help give them what we never got when we were learning.

That's a beautiful, full-circle moment.

But it wasn't all smooth sailing—because Jennifer and I don't always agree on mediumship approaches. And honestly? That's a good thing.

Why It's Good to Disagree in Mediumship

Jennifer and I had some brilliant debates about mediumship. And I loved it. Why?

- ✓ Because questioning what we believe is how we grow.
- ✓ Because there is no one right way to be a medium.
- ✓ Because different opinions push us to think deeper.

The students even noticed it—there were moments where I'd say something, and they'd be like, "That's different from what Jennifer taught us!" And for a second, I worried—was I undermining her? Was I letting her down?

But spirit made it clear—

"It's important that you disagree sometimes. That's how learning happens."

And the same goes for you—

- You don't have to agree with everything I say.
- You don't have to accept everything your teachers tell you.
- You should be questioning, exploring, and testing things for yourself.
- That's how mediumship evolves.

Different Approaches: My Style vs. Jennifer's

If you've ever wondered what different teaching styles in mediumship look like, here are a few ways Jennifer and I work differently:

1. Is Cause of Death Important Evidence?

- My View: I believe cause of death is an important piece of evidence—it helps an audience member quickly identify their spirit connection.
- Jennifer's View: She believes other forms of evidence are more valuable and that cause of death is less important.

Neither of us is wrong—it's just a different way of working.

2. Structuring a Message

- Jennifer's Approach: Get three strong pieces of evidence, each with a story attached.
- My Approach: Rapid-fire as much evidence as possible to find the recipient first, then unfold the story once you've confirmed the connection.

Again—both work, and both have their place.

3. Spirit Presenting as Someone Still Alive?

- Jennifer believes spirit will sometimes bring through evidence of someone still alive—almost as if they are “presenting” as that person.
- I believe spirit may talk about someone still here, but only after proving their own identity first.

Different perspectives. Both valid.

Why You Should Try Different Mediumship Styles

Here's the thing—

💡 If you only ever work the way you've been taught, you'll never discover what works best for you.

I see this all the time with students who come from very structured training—they struggle to break free and find their own flow.

Try different styles. Try new techniques. See what works for you.

Yes, it will feel awkward at first. Yes, it will be uncomfortable. But growth always is.
