A Tale of Two Demonstrations

This week, I had two back-to-back mediumship demonstrations, and let's just say... they were a study in contrasts.

The first one was at Chillum, and, well... let's just say it was a challenge. The audience was hesitant, quiet, and slow to engage, making the entire experience feel like wading through treacle. Even though my lovely friend Amanda was there writing down my evidence (because, let's be honest, I always get imposter syndrome afterward), the energy in the room just didn't flow.

The second demonstration, however, was at Deal Spiritual Centre, my first-ever church demonstration—and wow, what a difference! The energy was vibrant, the audience was open and receptive, and the evidence came through with such ease and joy.

These two experiences got me thinking about something important: Your mediumship style matters, and so does your audience.

Embracing Your Unique Mediumship Style

Mediums are individuals, and we all have our own distinct styles.

Some mediums work in a serious, soft-spoken, deeply emotional way—which is beautiful. But for me? Mediumship is a party.

Yes, we deal with grief. Yes, we are bringing through loved ones who have passed. But the fact that they're still alive in the spirit world is something to celebrate!

- ✨ They still have their personalities.
- ✨ They still have their humor.
- ✨ They still love you, watch over you, and know what's happening in your life.

And THAT is what my mediumship is about—joy, love, and connection.

I had a man come through in Chillum, and the first thing he said was:

“It’s a solar panel for my sex drive.”

Yes, that’s how spirit works! They don’t change. They don’t suddenly become all-knowing, angelic figures who only speak in profound riddles. They’re still them.

This realization has made me rethink how I market my demonstrations. If you want a quiet, solemn, serious night—I’m probably not the medium for you. If you want to laugh, cry, and truly celebrate your loved ones—then we’re a perfect match.

Audience Expectations & The Challenges of Mediumship

One thing I’ve noticed (and mediums, take note!) is that audiences often hold onto very specific expectations of what they want to hear.

I recently watched Tyler Henry’s show on Netflix (Life After Death), and while I absolutely love him, it’s fascinating to see how people interpret mediumship differently.

For example, Tyler once gave evidence about water being important in connection to a spirit. The woman confirmed it—her daughters had died in a mudslide. Some skeptics would say, “That’s not water, it’s mud,” but the connection is still valid.

This is what happens in demonstrations all the time.

A spirit may give me “Bob” when they were actually “Rob.” They might reference a house number 3, and the recipient says, “Well, they lived at 33, so that’s not quite right.”

These small details can cause hesitation, making the medium’s job harder. If an audience member is waiting for one specific phrase or one particular memory, they may dismiss everything else and assume the message isn’t for them.

Helping Mediums Help You

If you ever attend a mediumship demonstration, here’s how you can get the best experience:

✔ Be open-minded. The spirit world will try to bring through evidence in the best way they can, but it may not always be EXACTLY as you expect. ✔ Acknowledge what resonates. Even if all the details aren’t perfect, trust that the message is coming through for a reason. ✔ Don’t be afraid to raise your hand! If something sounds like it might be for you, acknowledge it—even if it’s not 100% what you expected.

Final Thoughts: Evolving as a Medium

This journey of mediumship is all about growth and resilience. Some nights will be tough, but each experience is an opportunity to learn and improve.

I’m now fully embracing my style as a medium. I want to make mediumship fun, uplifting, and celebratory—because I believe that’s what the spirit world wants, too.

So if you’re coming to one of my demonstrations in the future, expect to laugh, expect to cry, but most of all—expect to feel the joy of connection.
