Introduction: Meeting Courtney Dawson — Medium, Minister & Advocate for Ethical Mediumship

A Lifetime of Spirit Encounters: Courtney's Early Psychic Awakening

Courtney's connection to the spirit world began astonishingly early. Raised in a Christian home with strict beliefs about the afterlife, she had no language for what she was experiencing. Yet, from as young as one or two years old, she:

- Saw spirit children in her bedroom
- Witnessed them playing, hiding, and interacting
- Experienced them as solid and physical not misty or translucent
- Became confused only when they suddenly vanished

These moments imprinted on her memory with crystal clarity. Although she didn't understand them, they were real.

In her teenage years, without internet, mentors, or metaphysical resources, the overwhelming influx of emotions and psychic impressions became too much. She suppressed her mediumship as best she could, though her psychic awareness never fully shut down.

A Turning Point: Divorce, Reiki & the Reawakening of Her Mediumship

At age 30, Courtney went through a difficult divorce — a life event that became the catalyst for her spiritual gifts to resurface with full force.

A friend suggested Reiki. Courtney had no idea what to expect, but the session ignited everything:

- · Heightened clarity
- Intensified spiritual sensitivity
- Renewed contact with the spirit world
- An inner knowing that she could no longer ignore her calling

Spirit began guiding her through a series of synchronistic events, leading her directly into the heart of her mediumship journey.

The Night Everything Changed: A Parking Lot Reading That Altered Her Life Path Courtney attended a mediumship demonstration at a local Spiritualist church — having never seen a medium work before. As she waited for a friend in the parking lot, she suddenly saw a spirit man with two women crossing toward the church.

He spoke to her, asking her to deliver a message.

She tried to ignore him, but he followed his daughter and granddaughter into the church. Inside, an evidential medium and spirit artist delivered stunning portraits and messages. Meanwhile, Courtney saw spirit people emerging objectively from the wall behind the platform — matching the portraits exactly.

The persistent spirit man pressed her to deliver his message.

Trying desperately to avoid it, she made a deal with spirit:

- "I'll only give the message if they cross the street with me."
- \rightarrow They did.
- "Fine. Only if they parked beside me."
- → They had the same car, the same colour, and their key fob lit up right next to hers.

Courtney delivered the message in the parking lot - her first ever reading - and it was exactly what the family needed.

In that moment, she knew why she'd had spiritual encounters her entire life.

Finding a Spiritual Home: Training, Mentorship & Ordination

After the parking lot experience, everything accelerated:

- Spirit communication intensified
- She sought guidance at the same Spiritualist church
- Ministers recognised her gift instantly
- She joined their development circle
- She eventually trained for seven years
- And later became an ordained Spiritualist minister

Her mentor played a crucial role in helping her understand the work, navigate fear, and heal emotionally.

Developing Mediumship: The Commitment, the Surrender $\mathcal E$ the Inner Work Courtney describes mediumship development as:

- A lifelong process
- Deep personal work
- · Requiring surrender and trust
- Often involving healing past trauma
- Intensely emotional
- Sometimes overwhelming

She openly shares her experience of:

- A painful divorce
- Her children temporarily living with their father
- Moments of deep grief and breakdown
- Spirit comforting her with visions and presence
- Experiencing spirit as a constant source of unconditional love

Her mediumship evolved alongside her healing — a truth she believes applies to all mediums.

Courtney's View on Ethical Mediumship: What the Industry Needs Now Ethics are central to Courtney's work and teaching. She believes the mediumship world is missing some crucial foundations. Key issues she identifies:

1. Lack of Evidence in Readings

A true evidential medium must provide information that clearly identifies the spirit communicator.

Without it, doubt remains — and that undermines the purpose of mediumship.

2. Psychic Information Disguised as Mediumship

General statements like:

- "Who's the grandmother with heart problems?"
- "Who knows a woman who smoked?"

...are psychic, not mediumship.

3. Fishing for Information

Mediums should never ask recipients to give details they can then feed back.

4. Fear-Based Predictions

Spirit does not deliver messages of doom, fear, or disaster.

In thousands of readings, Courtney has never seen spirit bring harmful or frightening predictions.

5. Over-Reliance on Tools & Rituals

Some teachers online claim you must use:

- Cards
- Crystals
- Pendulums
- Candles
- Incense
- Rituals

...but Courtney emphasises:

"You only need one connection first — the connection to yourself."

Mediumship is natural. The tools are optional, not required.

6. Spiritual Codependency

She warns against:

- Students becoming reliant on mentors
- Followers becoming dependent on spiritual influencers
- People feeling they can't connect without external props

Spirit wants empowerment, not dependence.

A Conversation About Fraud in the Industry

During the podcast, Hannah reveals new information she has uncovered regarding allegations of fraud involving a prominent historical medium. Courtney responds with honesty, shock, and openness.

This conversation highlights:

- The importance of transparency
- The need to question narratives
