Welcome to Mediumship Matters!

Does this prove there is an ultimate meaning and reality? Does it mean someone or something is in charge? Or does this not necessarily follow at all? I'd love to hear your viewpoint because I've been mulling it over a lot lately. I adore the show—seriously, it's amazing! I'm working on my evidential mediumship at the moment and would love to one day travel to the UK and learn from you. Love from Tasmania!”

My Thoughts – Are We All God?

Wow, Eva, what a brilliant question! And one that's nearly impossible to answer in a way that fully encapsulates the mystery of existence. But here's what I currently believe:

◆ I believe that we are all God, and God is us. ◆ When we transition into the spirit world, we return to a state of oneness—and that oneness is God. ◆ I don't believe in a biblical-style God—a single, omnipotent being in charge of everything. ◆ Instead, I see life as an opportunity for experience—we come here to play, to love, to grow, to learn.

💡 “I think of it like a giant scrapbook—when we pass over, we all sit together and flick through it, laughing at how we crossed paths, how we annoyed each other, and how it all connected in ways we didn't see at the time.”

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Is There Someone in Charge?

◆ Part of me likes the idea of a guiding presence, but I resist the thought of an external 'higher power' controlling everything. ◆ If there is a divine force in charge, I believe we are also that force—it is not separate from us. ◆ This challenges the traditional idea that power is outside of us—many of us still like to believe something 'bigger' is making the decisions.

💡 “If there is a God, then I believe we are all fragments of that divine consciousness, experiencing itself in different forms.”

Jesus, Ascended Masters & Divinity

◆ I don't believe Jesus was any more divine than any other human being. ◆ However, I love working with Jesus as an Ascended Master—he's an absolute babe! ◆ I believe he was an incredibly gifted medium—someone who naturally allowed a deep and direct connection to spirit. ◆ I don't see him as the Son of God in the traditional sense—but rather as someone who fully embodied divine wisdom.

💡 “We are all divine, and we all have the potential to connect deeply with spirit—just like Jesus did.”

The Limits of Human Understanding

◆ One of the biggest challenges? Our human brains aren't equipped to fully grasp the nature of existence. ◆ My views today might evolve—if I ask myself this same question in two years, I might have an entirely different answer! ◆ Consciousness is constantly expanding, and our understanding of spirituality grows alongside it.

💡 “Maybe one day, I'll be able to fully articulate what I feel. But for now, I just accept that I don't know everything—and that's okay.”

Final Thoughts – Trust Your Own Beliefs

Eva, I hope this gives you something to sit with rather than making your existential crisis worse! 😊

💡 Key takeaways: ✓ I believe we are all God—divine fragments experiencing life. ✓ The spirit world is oneness—not a hierarchical heaven with a 'boss'. ✓ Jesus was a great medium and spiritual teacher—not the exclusive 'Son of God'. ✓ Our understanding is constantly evolving—and that's a good thing!

At the end of the day, take what resonates and leave what doesn't. Your own experiences and intuition are your best guides.
