Reflections, Money & Trusting Spirit's Plan

Listener Feedback: Smoke & Mirrors Episode

I received two very different responses to my Smoke & Mirrors episode, and I found both perspectives fascinating.

Miranda's Perspective

Miranda reached out saying that Smoke & Mirrors completely resonated with her—so much so that it validated why she stepped away from professional mediumship. She also recommended the book *Conversations with God* by Neale Donald Walsch, which explores psychic ability, reincarnation, and the soul's journey.

Miranda, I love that recommendation! I'm already listening to it and, let's be honest, God has a LOT to say—it's a 24-hour listen! But I love being challenged by new perspectives, so thank you.

Susie's Perspective: The Money Discussion

Susie, a new student in my school, had a very different take on the episode. She felt I was suggesting that people shouldn't make money from their spiritual gifts and that I was speaking from a place of financial entitlement.

Susie, I want to address this head-on because money and spirituality are tricky topics, and I never want anyone to feel judged.

- I do charge for my work.
- I believe mediums should be paid well.
- But I also believe mediumship shouldn't be forced into a financial structure that suffocates it.

What I was really trying to say is there's a difference between making a fair income from your work and demanding that your spiritual practice provide for you in a specific way.

For years, I told spirit, "My readings need to pay my bills." And I struggled. The moment I let go of that demand, my financial situation improved.

- This isn't about not making money—it's about allowing abundance to come without controlling how it happens.

“If you tell spirit, ‘I need to make money,’ they will bring you opportunities. But if you tell spirit, ‘I need to make money ONLY from mediumship,’ you might be blocking better options.”

Does this mean every medium should have a side job? No. It’s different for everyone. But if your only source of income is mediumship, you have to be brutally honest about when you’re forcing it.

A Real-Life Example: When Spiritual Work Becomes a Struggle

One of my Reiki students went all in too soon—renting a treatment room, buying high-end equipment, and investing heavily before she had clients.

- Within months, the pressure became unbearable.
- She had a chronic illness and was forcing herself to heal others while in pain.
- She felt trapped—she needed clients to pay for the space, but she wasn’t in an energetic place to work.

That’s what I was trying to express. If your spiritual work is your income, but you’re in survival mode, your energy isn’t aligned for giving.

Would I refuse to do a reading if I desperately needed the money? I can’t say I would. But I know that reading wouldn’t be my best work. And that’s something every medium needs to sit with.

Pricing & Energy Exchange

I charge £150 for a reading. Some people say that’s not enough. Others say it’s too much. Pricing is deeply personal. I want to be accessible but also attract the right clients—people who respect the work.

- Your pricing should align with your energy.
- You should feel comfortable with what you charge.
- Abundance comes when you’re in flow, not when you’re strangling the process.

Trance Message from Charles

To close out Season 5, I recorded a trance session with my guide, Charles. Here’s the core of his message:

“Your only job is to nurture your own light. The best gift you can give the world is to stand in your joy, not to force yourself into action for others.”

He spoke about how many of us feel obligated to carry the world’s weight, when in reality, our true purpose is to be light.

“There will always be heaviness in human life. The key is to minimise its impact on you.”

And most importantly:

“Stop waiting for permission. Spirit will not give it to you. Choose your joy NOW.”

Final Thoughts: Let Go & Trust Spirit

As we wrap up Season 5, here’s my takeaway:

- Abundance isn’t about demanding—it’s about aligning.
- Spirit knows what they’re doing—trust them.
- You don’t need permission to do what you love—just start.
