Messages & Validations from Spirit

💡 Grandmother's love for hosting:

- She showed herself laying the dining table in spirit, still preparing for family gatherings.
- Tablecloths and serving dishes—she kept everything just so!
- The family home was central to their identity.

💡 Grandfather's quiet strength & humour:

- He let his wife take charge but rolled his eyes with love.
- Showed himself fixing an old clock—Kath's family confirmed he had a cuckoo clock he regularly wound up and repaired.

💡 Personal family details:

- The name Mary—which turned out to be Kath's middle name, her daughter's middle name, and her other grandmother's name.
- Their home décor—floral wallpaper and fresh flowers in vases.
- Spring birthdays in the family & daffodil connections—Kath's grandad's birthday was on Daffodil Day!
- Their gravesite—Kath confirmed there is a potted rose placed there.

- ◆ Grandfather's service in uniform:
 - I saw him in a uniform as a young man.
 - Kath later verified he was in National Service, driving lorries and transporting POWs.
 - A photo of him in uniform exists in the family.
- ◆ Grandfather's DIY skills:
 - He loved fixing things in unorthodox ways.
 - I saw him repairing a leak with tape—Kath's family confirmed he once repaired an exhaust with a tomato can!
- ◆ Community involvement & bicycle reference:
 - I saw him cycling around, well-known in the community.
 - Kath later confirmed he met her grandmother while cycling!
 - He was deeply involved in helping elderly neighbours get home from social clubs.
- ◆ Afterlife signs & personal connection:
 - A special bond between Kath and her grandfather—a quieter, deeper connection.
 - He acknowledged her childhood memories of staying with them often.
 - A robin visiting Kath and her parents—he confirmed this was him.
 - Encouragement for Kath to follow her dreams and put herself first.

The Feedback – Validations & Surprising Confirmations

After the reading, Kath spoke to her family, and here's what they confirmed:

✔ Grandad's uniform—he was in National Service, not the Home Guard. ✔ Daffodil connection—his birthday was on Daffodil Day, and he had a hand-knitted daffodil jumper. ✔ The cuckoo clock—he was obsessed with keeping it wound up and working. ✔ The name John—his nephew was Johnny, and his stepfather was John. ✔ Potted rose on their grave—yes, confirmed. ✔ Tea set & ornamental cups—family inherited a teapot & porcelain pieces. ✔ Hyacinths in the house—confirmed by her mum. ✔ Grandad's DIY 'fixes'—he once patched an exhaust with a tomato can, and their outside toilet pipe had tape around it. ✔ Guardian angels in coffin—Kath's aunt placed glass guardian angel figures with him.

The feedback was incredible, with so many validations that Kath didn't even know at the time!

Final Thoughts – Honest Mediumship & Real Connections

💡 Key takeaways: ✔ Mediumship isn't always 100%—sometimes details unfold later. ✔ It's okay to say “no” in a reading—those no's might turn into a yes after validation. ✔ Spirit communication is real, emotional, and deeply personal. ✔ The best readings bring love, laughter, and proof that our loved ones are still with us.
