Live Mediumship Demonstration

But if we, as working mediums, aren't willing to show the real side of this work, we're setting impossible expectations for those who are developing their abilities.

So, here it is—unedited, from start to finish, including every awkward pause, every moment of doubt, and every powerful spirit connection. Whether you're a medium yourself or simply curious about how this all works, I hope you find it insightful!

What to Expect in a Live Demonstration

If you've never attended a mediumship demonstration before, here's how it works:

- The Spirit World Communicates Through Energy
- Spirits don't have a voice box, so they communicate with us through energy—what I like to call energetic charades. Sometimes they give me words, sometimes feelings, sometimes pictures, and sometimes it's just a deep inner knowing.
- No, They Don't Always Say 'The Password'
- Sitters often expect their loved ones to say a specific phrase to prove it's them. While that can happen, spirit communication isn't a simple exchange of words. It's a dynamic, flowing experience that requires trust on both ends.
- Every Reading is an Experiment
- Some readings are spot-on from the start, others take time to piece together. Spirit communication isn't a fixed science—it's a collaboration between medium, sitter, and the spirit world.

Key Themes from This Demonstration

During this live demonstration, I connected with several spirits, each bringing their own unique energy and messages. Some of the standout moments included:

- A Pocket Rocket Grandmother
- A spirited, no-nonsense woman with a wicked laugh and a sharp wit. She had lived alone for years and had strong opinions about how things should be done. Her presence was undeniable, and she brought laughter and warmth to the evening.

- A Proud Grandfather Who Loved His Garden
- He stood with his hands in his pockets, proudly surveying his flowers and vegetables. He had served in the military and carried a quiet strength, a stark contrast to his lively wife who often took center stage.
- A Young Man Who Left Too Soon
- A deeply moving connection with a young man who took his own life, leaving behind a family shattered by grief. He wanted to acknowledge the love that surrounded him, even though he hadn't been able to fully receive it in life.
- A Little Girl Who Danced in Spirit
- A beautiful, bright little soul who had battled illness and passed at a young age. She showed herself twirling in a dress, full of joy and light, bringing comfort to her family that she was still near.
- A Mother's Love & Strength
- A mother who passed too soon, offering reassurance to her daughter who had cared for her through illness. She acknowledged the challenges her daughter faced and wanted her to know she was still supporting her from the other side.

Mediumship is raw, unpredictable, and emotional. Sometimes, connections flow effortlessly; other times, they take time to build. This demonstration highlights the full spectrum of mediumship—the laughter, the emotion, the beautiful connections, and the moments of uncertainty.

If you're a developing medium, let this be your reminder: You don't have to be perfect. Trust the process, trust the spirit world, and most importantly, trust yourself.
